JSPM's Charak College of Pharmacy & Research, Wagholi organized session of Ms. Sonali Bhandarkar, Manager CSR Initiatives and Communications, DATRI blood stem cell donors registry on **Blood Stem Cell Donation** on 14/01/2020 at classroom, second floor. Dr. S. B. Wankhede, Principal, welcomed madam by offering bouquet as token of love. Madam is working at DATRI which is a communication creating awareness about blood stem cell donation. She explained about DATRI organization founded with a mission to save lives of those suffering from life threatening Fatal blood disorders like Blood Cancer, Thalassemia, Leukemia, Aplastic Anemia, Sickle Cell Anaemia etc. DATRI is working towards creating a wide and diverse database of potential Blood Stem Cell Donors that can be accessed by any patient, living anywhere in the world, in need of a Blood Stem Cell Transplant. DATRI is registered with Government of India as a Section 8 organization and all monetary contributions towards DATRI are subject to 80G exemptions.

Further she discussed that Peripheral blood stem cell (PBSC) donation is a nonsurgical procedure to collect blood-forming cells for bone marrow transplants. The donation takes place at an experienced blood center or outpatient hospital facility that participates in PBSC collections for Be The Match. For 5 days leading up to your PBSC donation, you will be given injections of a drug called filgrastim to increase the number of blood-forming cells (also called blood stem cells) in your bloodstream.

On the day of your PBSC donation, your blood is removed through a needle in one arm and passed through a machine that will collect only the blood-forming cells. The remaining blood is returned to you through a needle in the other arm. This process is similar to what is used when donating blood platelets. She then discussed different case studies who donated blood stem cell and give life to patients. Faculty members and students did registration at DATRI. Dr. Mrs. P. S. Chaudhari proposed vote of thanks. Total 120 students were present for the lecture.
